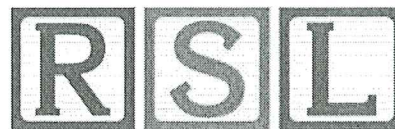
Reminders:

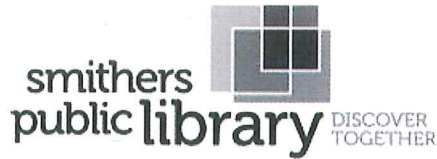

Dear Parents and Guardians,

The Smithers Public Library invites your child to participate in the 2022 BC Summer Reading Club: All Together Now.

Registration is free and starts at the Smithers Public Library on Monday May 30th. Children receive a reading record to help keep track of their summer reading fun. And, if they participate in the program, they'll be awarded a medal at the end of the summer!

Regular reading through the summer helps children maintain and improve reading skills while school is out of session. When children join the BC Summer Reading Club, they are encouraged to read whatever they wish (story books, information books, even comic books!), in whatever language they feel most comfortable. They can also listen to someone else read or tell stories.
